On Wednesday **August 8th & 15th 2018**, take a regular tour of the 1759 historic Upper Wolfsnare House & at 1:30 p.m. enjoy a special music presentation by the **Singing Storyteller, Larry Van Nostrand**.



Tours on these 2 days are from **Noon - 1:25 p.m.** and **start again immediately following the presentation until 4 p.m.**

Upper Wolfsnare is located at 2040 Potters Road in Virginia Beach and is open for Tours on Wednesdays in July and August from noon - 4 p.m.

The 1759 house was built by Thomas Walke III and was home to **Thomas Walke IV** who was a Princess Anne County representative who voted for the **Ratification of the US Constitution** in Richmond in 1788. **Come learn about life in colonial times in Princess Anne County as reflected in the music of the period!**
